Grades

Semester Honors

I. POLICY:

Students earning a minimum of 12 hours of graded credit in a single term with a term grade point average of 3.5 or above receive semester honors. Courses graded P, W, IN, S, U, or NC cannot be included in the 12 hours minimum.

II. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to define how semester honors are determined and who receives them.

III. DEFINITIONS:

- A. GPA: Grade Point Average; equivalent of the cumulative scholastic average.
- B. Semester Honors: Recognition given to students who achieve a GPA of 3.5 or higher for any single semester in which they are enrolled in 12 or more credits.

IV. PROCEDURES:

Students will automatically be awarded semester honors according to this policy.

V. RESPONSIBILITY:

The Records Office is responsible for calculating semester honors.
