Freshmen must submit Evidence of 2 of the following: a minimum GPA of 2.5, composite ACT score of 19 or higher or combined SAT score of 820 or higher, rank in upper 2/3 of student's graduating class. **Transfers** must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on previous college work.

Incoming Freshmen or Transfer Students portfolios are due by **10 AM** on the **4th Thursday in April**. All work must be picked up from 4-5 PM on the same day. **Please make prior arrangements if scheduled times are inappropriate for you to drop off work and pick it up.** Portfolios will be returned only if they are accompanied by sufficient postage and appropriate packaging.

PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS:

Six (6) pieces of artwork representing a minimum of two media, submitted in portfolio or appropriate container (something that will safely contain artwork, is easily moveable, reusable, clean, attractive, and well marked.) Matted, mounted, or framed as appropriate. Slides are acceptable, but actual art work is preferable whenever possible.

JUDITH RICHARDSON VISUAL ART SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been established to honor the memory of Judith Richardson. The scholarship is designed to assist art students at Adams State College. A scholarship committee, composed of ASC Art Department Faculty Members, will select the recipients. The amount of each award shall not exceed the cost of tuition and fees for any year. The amount awarded to each student will be determined by the committee.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS:

1. To be considered for the scholarship, the student must have applied for admission to Adams State College. (To receive the scholarship, the student must be enrolled as a full-time student at Adams State College and declare their major as art).
2. **Incoming freshmen** must meet two of the following three admissions criteria:
 - a. Have a minimum grade point average of **2.5** (in a system where 4.0 is the highest grade attainable).
 - b. Have a composite **ACT score of 19** or higher or combined **SAT score of 820** or higher.
 - c. **Rank in the upper two-thirds** of the student's graduating class.
3. **Transfer students** must have a cumulative grade point average of **2.5** or better for previous college work.
4. To retain the scholarship, **undergraduate recipients** must complete at least **15** semester hours per semester with a passing grade and maintain a cumulative grade point average of **2.5** or better at Adams State College.
5. To retain the scholarship, **graduate recipients** must complete a minimum of **9** semester hours each semester and must maintain a minimum **3.0** cumulative grade point average.
6. To retain the scholarship, **all recipients** must reapply each academic year. Renewal will **not** be automatic.
