

MA IN COACHING - ONLINE

By following this sequence of courses, a student can complete the MA in 4 semesters and 2 full summer terms. If a student falls out of this sequence then additional terms may be needed to complete the degree. Elective courses may be taken at any time (consult with advisor). Two campus residencies in June are required.

Summer 1

- Mandatory 2-day On Campus Orientation (within first 2 weeks of June)

- HPPE 527: Sport Law

Fall 1

- HPPE 509: Concepts in Exercise Science
- HPPE 536: Sport & Exercise Psychology

Spring 1

- HPPE 504: Methods of Coaching
- HPPE 539: Strength & Conditioning

Summer 2

- HPPE 543: Measurement & Evaluation
- 500-level Elective (if doing Option 2)

Fall 2

- HPPE 556: Strategic Management & Leadership in Sport
- HPPE 585: Practicum in HPPE
- HPPE 591: Thesis Proposal (Option 1)

Spring 2

- HPPE 538: Social Aspects of Sport & Physical Education
- HPPE 593: Thesis (Option 1) – OR - HPPE 596 Field Based Research (Option 2)

Summer 3

- Mandatory On-Campus Completion of HPPE 593 – OR - HPPE 596

HPPE Electives (Option 2/Field-Based Research must complete 3 credits of electives) – Electives may be taken at any time.
