To be recorded on CD/tape (CD is preferred):

- a) Please do NOT state your name, school, etc. on the recording
- b) Scales, w/ minimum performance requirements in parentheses
 - any Major Scale (2 octaves in 8th notes, Qtr note = 120)
 - any Harmonic Minor (2 octaves in 8th notes, Qtr note = 120)
 - Chromatic (2 octaves in 8th notes, Qtr = 80)
- c) The prepared music is selected from this year's All-State requirements. Students may send CDs with the full All-State requirements if they already are recording them, or they may send the reduced requirements below. Deviations from All-State requirements are noted in bold or ~~strikethrough~~.

Students proficient on more than one instrument (ex: flute/picc, oboe/English horn, high/low clarinet, trombone/euph, etc.) are strongly encouraged to audition on each instrument. Please use a separate CD/tape, and send them together.

p. 16, m. 26—end (dotted quarter note = 60)

[Treble-clef baritone must either transpose these etudes or play the trumpet etudes]

Bass Trombone Ostrander - Method for Bass Trombone (C. Fischer)

p.40, No. 2, all [no repeats, take 2nd ending] (quarter-note = 96)

p.40, No. 3, all [no repeats] (quarter-note = 132)

Tuba Ostrander - Concert Album for Tuba & Piano (Edition Musicus)

p.5 (*Gigue*), top—5th line, 2nd meas, 3rd beat (Bb) [no repeat] (dotted quarter note = 96)

p.6 (*Adagietto*), top - 4th line, 3rd meas, 2nd beat (F) (quarter-note = 60)

String Bass Piece(s) of your choice, demonstrating technique and musicality.

Percussion You must audition in **all three areas** and on the music listed below.

Mallets Whaley - Recital Pieces for Mallets (J. R. Publications)

p.28, 1st 4 lines [no repeat, stop on 1st note of 2nd ending] (eighth-note = 68-72)

Snare Drum Cirone - Portraits in Rhythm (Belwin-Mills)

[All rolls in concert style - multiple bounce]

p.15, No.13, **1st 3 lines plus one measure** (tempi as marked)

Timpani Whaley - Musical Studies for the Intermediate Timpanist (J.R. Publications)

p.3, **1st 4 lines plus 3 measures** [play on 2 drums] (tempi as marked)

Please note: if you are from a state other than Colorado, you may record your state's All-State audition music in lieu of the music listed above. If your state also specifies scales to be played in a different pattern, you may play them that way as well.
