APPLICATION PROCESS

PHASE II: Theme writing	When Phase I is complete, the student will sign up in the Field Services Office for one of two scheduled times during which the Education Theme Paper is written
PHASE III: Admission interview	The student will also sign up in the Field Services Office for an admission interview. Students meet with the Chair of their Interview Panel for results of their interview.

Note:

All coursework must be completed before the student teaching semester. Students must pass the PLACE or Praxis II content area exam before student teaching semester; scores must be received by teacher education no later than the 7th week of the Fall or Spring semester prior to student teaching or you will not be placed for student teaching.
