

**Transfer Guide for  
Pueblo Community College  
Students Planning on Transferring to  
Adams State College**

- I. Admissions Criteria & Procedures
- A. A 2.0 gpa is required for unconditional admission to ASC.
  - B. In determining the cumulative grade-point average at ASC, only work taken at Adams State will be used.
  - C. Students who have earned core complete AA or AS degrees from Pueblo Community College are considered for unconditional admission to ASC.
  - D. To apply for admission, the transfer student should do the following:
    - 1. Return completed application form
    - 2. Submit \$20 application fee
    - 3. Have Pueblo Community College send official transcript(s) directly to the Office of Admissions
    - 4. A student completing 12 hours or less of transfer work must also submit ACT/SAT scores and an official high school transcript.
- It is best to complete the admission by August 1 for the fall semester; December 1, for the spring semester; or May 1 for the summer session. (The scholarship deadline is March 15 and financial aid priority deadline is April 15 for the fall semester.)
- II. Transferring Credit
- A. Adams State will accept work in which grades of A, B, C, P (Pass), CR (Credit) and S were earned for transfer credit. D grades are not accepted for transfer unless the course is an integral part of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.
  - B. Students with Advanced Placement scores of 3 or higher and CLEP scores in the 50th percentile or higher may receive credit upon approval by the dean of the appropriate ASC school. (Original copies of the AP or CLEP scores must be received directly from The College Board.) Vocational courses and courses which are listed as no equivalent at ASC can be considered for credit after the student completes 24 hours of course work at ASC with a 2.0 or higher g.p.a. The dean of the school in which the student's major is located must approve the credit.
  - C. There is no limit on the number of transfer hours accepted, however, students are required to complete a minimum number of hours to obtain a Bachelor's degree. (See part D).
  - D. Pueblo Community College students must complete a minimum of 60 hours at ASC. (See section III, C).
  - E. All students are encouraged to plan a visit to ASC during their freshman year to tour the campus, sit in on classes and to meet with a major advisor relative to transfer.

- F. Transferable AA or AS degrees will satisfy all ASC general education requirements.
- G. Transfer credits more than 10 years of age must be evaluated by the ASC dean of the school where credit will be considered.
- H. The Colorado Common Core will be accepted in total as meeting all general education courses at ASC.
- I. Since Pueblo Community College has North Central accreditation, acceptable Pueblo Community College credits are transferred directly to ASC.

### III. Degree/Program Requirements

- A. Students who have not completed an AA degree, an AS degree or the Colorado Common Core will be required to meet the ASC general education requirements in effect at the time of admission to Pueblo Community College, provided they meet the requirements of III-D below.
- B. The bachelor's degree is conferred upon completion of a minimum of 124 semester hours, comprised of general education major requirements, and elective credit. Additional majors or minors are optional. A maximum of four semester hours of credit in physical education activity may be used to meet the 120 semester hour requirement. A cumulative scholastic average of 2.0 must be earned in all work attempted at ASC. (A 2.75 gpa is required for admission to Teacher Education.)
- C. As is required for native students, 45 semester hours of the course work required for a degree at ASC must be upper division (300-400 level). And, at least half of the required semester hours for any major must be completed at ASC. Transferring students, as well as native students, must exhibit proficiency in English by successful completion of acceptable course work and by passing a proficiency test.
- D. Pueblo Community College students must use the ASC catalog in effect at the time of their first registration at Pueblo Community College. This catalog remains in effect as long as they remain continuously registered both semesters of the academic year and they complete their bachelor's degree within seven years of the date of their first Pueblo Community College registration. If students cannot complete their requirements within seven years, they must meet the requirements in effect during their final year. Or, students have the option of using the requirements of more recent ASC catalogs.
- E. Requirements for majors, by Pueblo Community College, may be found in the ASC catalog.
- F. Transfer appeals should be brought to the Vice President of Student Affairs in Richardson Hall-RH 240. A detailed description of the state level appeal process is available in this office. Also, it is listed along with a Glossary of Transfer Terminology.
- G. The following pages contain the course-by-course transfer guide. Where we have elective, the class will transfer as an elective. These electives may be used toward degree requirements, but not in general education or major/minor

areas. Where we list no equivalent (no equiv) we are initially unable to transfer the hours toward a BA-BS degree. Vocational courses and courses which have no equivalent at ASC can be considered for credit after the student completes 24 hours of course work at ASC with a 2.0 or higher gpa. The credit must be approved by the dean of the school in which the student's major is located. Generally, when these classes have been accepted, they have been accepted as electives. Where we list non-transfer (non-tran) we may have a similar class, but cannot count the hours toward degree requirements on this campus.

Candidates for the Bachelor of Arts degree with secondary teacher licensure must complete a major in addition to the professional program in education. The major must be a subject field offered as an area of instruction in the Colorado secondary schools and must be approved by the Head of the Department of Teacher Education prior to the candidate entering the program. The student should select a major in consultation with an advisor in the Department of Teacher Education as there are several majors not approved for teacher certification and fields where employment is extremely limited.

The development of a teachable minor is strongly recommended to enhance employment opportunities.
