All applications will be reviewed by a panel of judges; participants will be selected based on 1) commitment to complete an outfit made from discarded material by October 31st, 2011, 2) clothing design concept and 3) creative use of material. Community Partnerships would like to exhibit a wide variety of discarded material for the recycle fashion exhibit, therefore, judges reserve the right to choose applicants based on choice of discarded material, preference will be given to those using material not easily recyclable.

Participant Objective:

To create a fashionable outfit made from man-made discarded material for use in Community Partnerships' Annual Recycled Fashion Show in November. To learn from renowned, recycle fashion designer.

Guidelines:

- Discarded material (previously used) must be the primary or dominant material in each outfit
- This primary material must be used, inorganic and man-made
