

# **MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL FREE THROW CONTEST**

General information regarding departmental policies and procedures can be obtained in the Recreational Sports Office, located in the Rex Activity Center.

**ENTRY/ROSTER:** Entry forms are due Tuesday, 20 October 2009 by 5PM to the IM/Sports Club office located in the Rex Activity Center.

**\*\*Members of the varsity basketball or club basketball teams are ineligible to participate in this event.\*\***

**COMPETITION:** All participants must present a valid Adams State College photo I.D. card prior to competing. The Free Throw contest will be held in the Rex Activity Center gym on Thursday, 23 October 2009, starting at 7pm.

**LOCATION:** Rex Activity Center gym

**RULES:** Each contestant will shoot 25 free throws. The top three contestants from each category with the most baskets made (out of 25) will advance to the final round. In the event of a tie in this round, all players with similar top scores will advance. These contestants will shoot 25 shots again. The contestant with the most made baskets will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie in the final round, there will be a 10-shot shoot-off on the same night until a winner is determined.

**UNIFORMS:** Uniforms are not required for this tournament.

**RESCHEDULING:** Rescheduling will not be allowed for this event.

**EQUIPMENT:** The Recreational Sports Office will provide all equipment.

**AWARDS:** Gift cards will be awarded to the men's and women's champions.

**SCHEDULES:** This is a drop-in event. Participants may show up to the Rex Activity Center at any time between the hours of 7:00-7:30 PM to be included in this competition. *Entrants after 7:30 will not be scheduled in the competition.*

**FORFEIT POLICY:** Since this is a single day event, participants who forfeit will be eliminated from competition.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** Inherent risks are associated with every recreational activity. Participants assume these risks when they agree to participate. All participants are strongly advised to secure health insurance coverage and to visit their physician for a physical examination prior to registration or participation.
