

DODGEBALL TOURNAMENT

Captain's Meeting: There is no captain's meeting schedule for this event.

ENTRY/ROSTER: Entry forms are due on Tuesday, 10 November 2009 no later than 5:00 PM. A maximum of 12 participants are allowed per roster.

Due to this being a one day tournament, there is no Drop/Add deadline. The players listed on the roster are the only ones allowed to participate on that team.

COMPETITION: All participants must present a current, valid Adams State College photo I.D. card prior to each game.

LOCATION: In the Rex Activity Center

RULES: A complete set of rules is included with this packet.

RESCHEDULING: Rescheduling for this activity will not be allowed, as it is a one day tournament.

UNIFORMS: Uniforms are not required to participate in this league. It is important that all team members wear long sleeves and long pants.

EQUIPMENT: will be provided by the Student Life and Recreation Department.

AWARDS: team gift card

SCHEDULES: one schedule of games will be emailed to each captain, on Friday, 5 December 2008.

ALL PLAYERS MUST SHOW CURRENT ADAMS STATE COLLEGE ID IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE – NO ID, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: Inherent risks are associated with every recreational activity. Participants assume these risks when they agree to participate. All participants are strongly advised to secure health insurance coverage and to visit their physician for a physical examination prior to registration or participation.

FORFEIT POLICY: game time is forfeit time. Any team that does not show up by game time will be declared in forfeit & will be immediately eliminated from the tournament.



Intramural Dodgeball Rules

1. Teams consist of 5-6 people.
2. Start at the back line, balls start in the middle. Can not run forward until the whistle is blown to start play.
3. Any player stepping over the middle line is automatically ejected.
4. Players can only leave the court of play to retrieve a ball. Delayed entrance to the court can result in an ejection at the official's discretion.
5. Players are out if they:
 - are pegged by a dodgeball on the fly without it being caught
 - an opponent catches a throw on the fly or off a deflection, not including off the ground
 - they leave the court of play for any reason outside of retrieving a ball
 - stepping over the middle attack line
 - attempt to block a ball with another ball and they drop the defending ball
6. All calls by the officials are final.
7. Technical fouls are issued for poor sportsmanship at the discretion of the official.
8. Players can re-enter the game off a catch by a teammate in the order of elimination. The first person eliminated is the first person in the game off a catch.
9. The game is over when all members of a team are eliminated or 15 minutes have elapsed.
 - Each team will be awarded a point for each remaining player on the court after the 15 minute game time has ended.
 - Each team will be awarded 3 points for a win, 2 for a tie, 0 for a loss.
10. If it recommended that all participants wear long sleeves and sweatpants.
11. Deliberate throws at the head are not allowed – players deliberately aiming at an opponent's head will automatically be **ejected from the tournament** & there will be a 5 point penalty assessed to their team. However, players ducking or dodging to get out the way are taking their chances at being hit in the head.

This is a Round Robin format, guaranteeing each team at least 2 games. Every team that does not forfeit will make the single elimination playoffs.
