

EADA 2015-16

The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) is intended to make prospective students aware of a school's commitment to providing equitable opportunities for its men and women students.

Any coeducational institution of higher education that participates in an FSA program and has an intercollegiate athletic program must prepare an annual EADA report. The report contains participation rates, financial support and other information on men's and women's intercollegiate athletic programs.

The University will provide a paper copy of the Report upon request.

Data collection for the annual EADA Survey will close on October 28, 2016. After the data has been reviewed and approved by the Department of Education, complete survey results will be available on the Department of Education's EADA website.
